



erroneous thinking that many people have toward money and wealth. He never advocated a poverty consciousness nor defined spirituality as having to do without the necessities of life. In fact, he encourages all of us to think about abundance and to work to achieve it. He skillfully shows how being financially prosperous helps us achieve our spiritual goals.

It has been my goal to bring this kind of prosperity consciousness in everything that we do at TSG Foundation. I hope you enjoy this article and strive to achieve the abundance that is truly yours to have.

## Higher Levels of Prosperity Consciousness: Part One

Q & A with Torkom Saraydarian

*Question: Is it a virtue to be poor?*

**Answer:** I would say that to be poor is not a virtue; it is a sin. But to be poor in the sense that you give all that you get and you give all that you are is the greatest virtue. If you give yourself and if you give whatever you have and do not attach to your givingness, and if you do not expect things to be given back, what you have is a great virtue because it is a poverty that has spiritual meaning. You are and you have, not for yourself but for the whole, for the whole of humanity. You can be poor within great wealth, if you are using your wealth in such a way that you do not have strings tied to it.

Now, this does not mean that you are not going to use your own money and your own virtues and abilities to keep yourself healthy and up-to-date, but you will keep yourself in such a state that you are useful and you expend the least amount of time and energy so that you can do greater service. This means that whatever you are doing for yourself will be done with the intention of helping others and with the intention of giving all that you have to better conditions, in better ways. This is the real meaning of poorness, of poverty.

*Question: Is it man's divine heritage to be rich, wealthy, healthy, a "child of God"?*

**Answer:** I think this phrase is a phrase used by some, but I can say that it is a divine heritage, of course. You are going to be as God is, which means He has everything but He gives everything, just like a Sun that radiates for others. That is His nature, to give. But you cannot give if you do not have. To have means not only to have matter, but also knowledge,

joy, great spiritual visions, wisdom, and understanding. These things you can give also. Now these things are also richness, wealth.

Prosperity means, in its esoteric sense, that you are always increasing your communication with the Cosmos in such a harmonious way that greater energies and virtues and wealth are poured out into your system so that you pass them on and give them to others. You are acting here as a steward; you are channeling energy. To channel the energy in better ways, of course, your pipe or mechanism must be in good condition. You are not making yourself rich or healthy for the sake of yourself but for the sake of others.

*Question: Is success divinely approved?*

**Answer:** Of course, yes. Christ said, "Be perfect as your Father in heaven is perfect." To be perfect means to be extremely successful. Success does not mean to accumulate money. Success means to be more yourself, to be more divine, and to be closer to the divine resources of everything. Then the next goal of success is to give — successfully to get and successfully to give. Now this is divinely approved, of course. You see, anytime you receive and you do

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not give, or you give and you do not receive, you are not in balance with the Purpose and Plan of the Divine Intent.

*Question: Should one expect prosperity as a spiritual blessing?*

**Answer:** Of course, yes. But as Buddha said, with the right means. You cannot be prosperous if you are using the wrong means, wrong intentions and goals, and wrong motives. You can be materially rich, but you can be spiritually poor. You must have money, and this money must be based on your right spiritual motive. If the right motive is not there, you can have money but you are poor — that is, poor in the sense of miserableness.

You do not have anything, actually, because it is not success to have things. To have things, to accumulate is not success. Success starts when those accumulated things are accumulated with the right motive, with the right purpose, and are used and spent in the right directions and with the right motives. Now there is the richness. Richness is not having money, and poverty is not being without money. You can be poor in conditions of great wealth. If you are not attached to your wealth and if you dedicate that wealth to meet the needs of others, you will appropriate and distribute it in such a way that the wealth increases in others and makes them more successful physically, emotionally, mentally, and spiritually.

Prosperity is nothing else but the process of being the cooperater of the Divine Glory, the Divine riches. Why not? You are divine and you must partake in the Divine Glory in your own life and be a king of beauty, of health, of wisdom, of your surroundings so that in these conditions you help others to a greater extent.

*Question: Since “energy follows thought” and “where you put your thought is what you eventually draw to yourself”—radiation and attraction—it*

*means one can have what one puts enough thought into. But where does karma enter into the picture?*

**Answer:** Karma is not something made up and finished. Karma is an ever changing pattern, an ever changing blueprint of your future. You can change anytime any karma, or modify it. Let us say, your karma is not to have money, but when you are using your mind you are putting some causes into action and you are changing your previous karma of not having money. Now you are not going to be subject to the initial karma because slowly, slowly, you are breaking the opposition of your past karma and modifying it and building a new karma.

*Question: Can positive thinking help you over the obstacles of life?*

**Answer:** I would say that it does and it does not. For example, if you are thinking positively but you are dreaming and not working and you are not using your mind for practical ways and means to actualize your positive thinking, then you are becoming a dreaming person; you are dreaming. Obstacles of life can be overcome not only by positive thinking but also by acting and working practically with your hands and feet and brain and heart to overcome these obstacles. For example, positive thinking is not dreaming, as some of the people preach. Positive thinking, in my own interpretation, is a thinking which finds all the ways and means to overcome your own obstacles while having the greatest faith in your heart that if a man can do something, so can another man. That is positive thinking in my own opinion.

*Question: You said something about Shambhalla deciding that an individual should not get something in order that it might be a test for the individual. Are we not the masters of our souls and the captain of our ship?*

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**Answer:** Of course we are not. If you are identified with your physical, emotional, and mental body you are just a machine, and the natural energies and events and spirits and forces use you as a fertilizer in many directions. You do not own yourself yet. You are owned by the natural forces or by the people who have greater mastery over themselves. They can use you as a slave. And that is what the Nature does, unless you become a member of the headquarters of the Nature, which means you become a controller, a master, so that eventually you can master your destiny. Being “captain of your ship” is a beautiful symbol. You can be the captain of your ship but not the captain of the sea, unless you have power also over the ocean. Do you see? You can be a good captain but when the waves come, they hit you.

*Question: Does one just have to make do with the little that he has?*

**Answer:** No. Christ gave this explanation. A man gave \$5, \$10, and \$15 to three people and the one who received \$10 brought back \$100, and the one who received \$15.00 brought back \$3000, but the one who received the least went and buried it under the ground. This means that the divine intent is to make you develop whatever is given to you. Unfold it, increase it, until your little pool becomes part of the great ocean. Now you can think about that symbolism.

*Question: What is the “Vacuum Law”?*

**Answer:** The “Vacuum Law” is the need and the answer to the need. And that need must be a need that others must profit from. For example, let us say that I need an esoteric school. This is not MY need; it is a need FOR OTHERS. Now if that need is really a need for others and others are ready for that need, that need will be answered. You are creating the need in a way that is asking but that asking

is based on the need. You say, “My Lord, I need an esoteric school so that I may train your children.” Now that is my need, but my need is to have the right conditions to teach them and their need is to have that school in which to be taught. It is their need, you see.

Even your personal need may be legitimate. For example, you say, “I am in a condition that I need greater wisdom to overcome these obstacles.” Now you are creating a vacuum and that vacuum is going to be filled if you do your utmost, your UT-MOST. Do not forget that. If you help yourself, God helps you.

*Question: Can you comment on the “as if” law? Is this when a person acts as if he is already there?*

**Answer:** The “as if” method is totally different than what is commonly taught. You see, the “as if” method means “as if you are.” Let me explain it very beautifully. “As if” is not a law. I cannot say that it is a law, but it is a technique in which, for example, you imagine that you are a disciple and you act and behave according to what you think a disciple is. In this way you are creating a greater vision, and this greater vision is eventually molding you upon the vision. The same is true when you are thinking that you will be a very successful person. What are you doing? First, you are repelling all the imported negative ideas against your success, whether they are from dark forces or whether they are from your friends or whether they are from your own fabrications. When you are saying, “What if I am really successful?” you are creating a thoughtform and that thoughtform is putting into action your whole mechanism to achieve this success. Also, in your subjective relationships with others it is doing the same so that you are a successful man.

But, again, the “as if” method must be used totally to perfect yourself and to have richness and

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many other things for the sake of others, to help others, to be a path for others. During the time of your development, a time will come that you suddenly will realize that you do not belong to yourself. You will understand that you are there just to help others. In this service, in this activity and sacrifice, you sublimate yourself. You are transformed and you become a master without even seeing, without even realizing that you have already become a master. This is the right path on which you do not develop vanities or show-off.

*Question: Can giving make you rich?*

**Answer:** This is wrong thinking. When you are giving, you should not have the intention to become rich. You just give because there is a need. That is why I said that most of the lectures on prosperity are wrong when they say, "Give 5%, 10%, 50% so that you become rich and the money starts to flow to you." Now this is wrong thinking, to me. **In my opinion, you are going to give to be poor, not to be rich.** Do you understand what I mean? See, you are giving without any expectation that you are going to have because you gave. Expectation can work for a while but then it will reverse itself and whatever you built for yourself in the process of giving to others to be rich yourself, all these things will fall into the river and into the flood because the foundation was wrong. You always are intended to give rather than to be rich, but when you give and you give in the right way with the right motives, things will be given to you to give more.

*Question: How about tithing, giving back to the Lord. One-tenth sounds very cheap and old age, but what about it?*

**Answer:** Let us come to tithing. Tithing, as I said, is just on the level of the children. A man, if he has a child's consciousness, must be taught to start giving something. Tithing is a very good law to teach

people how to start giving. When they learn tithing, you are going to tell them that tithing is not enough. You are going slowly to dedicate, to donate, and to sacrifice yourself completely. See? So we are not actually throwing out the tithing, but we are going to correct the motivation of tithing.

If the motivation of tithing is to give \$5.00 out of your \$50.00 to the Lord, whatever that means, in order to have money, that is just a comedy for us. For the children of the human race, it is good! It is good. But now we are going to correct even the motive of the children of the race when they are tithing. What are we going to tell them? We are going to tell them, "You earn \$50.00 and you need that \$50.00, but you are going to share some of it, 10% for example, with others so that you help them to make more money, to be more prosperous, and in this way you show your love for them." Now in this manner, you do not make them give so as to be rich, but you make them give to help others. When they see that they are helping in better and better ways, they will work harder to make more money to help more.


